## Chinese New Year Day Camp

Praise the Lord that the Chinese New Year Day Camp was held successfully from 17 to 19 February 2021. We provided limited service due to the pandemic. All kids followed precautionary measures while participating in the day camp. We were blessed to be supported by many different organizations: The International Peace Youth Group (IPYG), Commonwealth Bank Australia, Mighty Charitable Foundation Limited, and the Hong Kong Association of Therapeutic Horticulture. The day camp had four components: craft-making session, horticultural therapy workshop, Bible storytelling, and board game session.

### Craft-making

Volunteers from IPYG prepared a craft-making session for our kids. The kids were guided to make English storybooks, titled “My Value,” “The Elephant’s Dung” and “From Football to Wisdom.” Kids were busy with designing their storybooks! They learned English vocabulary. They also learned to value themselves, pursue dreams, and keep a positive attitude in facing difficulties.



## Horticultural Therapy Workshop

Students with Special Education Needs find learning stressful. Horticultural Therapy aims at reducing their stress levels. It helped to improve the kids' memory, cognitive abilities, task initiation, language skills, and socialization. The kids learned the technique of cottage, flower pounding, and planting air plants during the workshop. They were fascinated by learning to plant the seedlings and make crafts with different flowers and herbs. They had so much fun getting dirty with different plants and mud.



## Bible Storytelling

Kids learned bible stories during the session. They were curious to watch an animation about the beginning of the world. They learned about God creating the world. They also learned to obey God's rules, and how God loves us and forgives our sins.



## Board Game

The kids had less opportunity to play with one another due to the pandemic. Thanks to the volunteers from Commonwealth Bank Australia and the International Peace Youth Group, the kids were very excited playing board games with the volunteers and staff.



## Super Sunday

Super Sunday starts at 3 pm on Sunday at Kids' Learning Club, Saint Barnabas' Society and Home. The kids learn English through Superbook movie played in English language and English subtitles. The kids love watching the Superbook English Bible story animation video. Our senior minister Herisa Chan spoke in English during the whole Superbook one-hour session. She interacted with the kids in English, told the Bible story, highlighted the lesson learned, taught the Bible Scriptures, and prayed with the kids. The kids and their mothers lovingly read the Scriptures together. What a beautiful experience! Jesus loves the kids as well as their moms.



We have resumed KLC Super Sunday since 17 Jan 2021, with limited number of kids and parents participating due to social distancing under pandemics. We have run Super Sunday Superbook session online since 7 February 2021, so that more kids can join at home during Covid-19 restrictions. Kids are happy to join the Super Sunday.
